□ Written essay 1	<ul> <li>No more than 500 words</li> <li>Description: Tell us about your prior experience with health innovation and health equity. How does the East Africa Biodesign fellowship fit into your future plans? How do you hope to use your training after the fellowship?</li> </ul>
□ Written essay 2	<ul> <li>No more than 300 words</li> <li>Describe a time when a partnership was necessary to achieve your desired outcome. What was your role in creating or maintaining the partnership and what have you learned from this experience?</li> </ul>
