



POLICY TITLE: Graduation Academic Regalia			
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PURPOSE

- At UGHE commencement and other formal academic events, faculty and guests of honor must wear academic regalia, specifically, a gown, cap and hood. Regalia is seen as an important part of formal academic events, and regalia often reflects the degree held by the individual and distinguishes those governing the institution.
- Graduands also wear graduation regalia at their graduation ceremony.
- This policy outlines the guidelines for wearing regalia at UGHE commencement and formal academic events, and the type of regalia worn by faculty and graduands.

DEFINITIONS

Academic regalia: A traditional form of clothing worn by graduands and faculty in commencement, composed of gown, hood, mortarboard with tassel.

Commencement: The ceremony where graduands celebrate the successful completion of their academic credential.

Graduand: A student who is approved, yet to confer.

Graduate: A student whose academic credential has been conferred.

Student: An individual enrolled in any course (credit or non-credit) at UGHE.

SCOPE

This policy applies to all faculty and graduands who have been approved to graduate and will participate in the University's commencement. It also applies to faculty who are required to attend a formal academic event where regalia is required, as determined by UGHE senior leadership.

General regalia guidelines

- Graduands and faculty attending any ceremony where regalia is required must wear the appropriate academic gown, cap and hood.






Academic staff

- Academic regalia is an apparel that recognizes academic accomplishments.
- Only academic faculty, staff with academic appointments, graduands and designated guests can wear the academic regalia in the academic ceremonies

- Faculty and students should wear the regalia indicating the highest degree attained
- In any UGHE ceremony or event, only UGHE approved regalia can be worn
- No personal décor of any kind is allowed to be added or placed on the regalia
- Clothing must be worn under the regalia
- Only one hood and one cap should be worn at any given time

Description of regalia

At UGHE, leadership, faculty, special guests, and students will wear regalia. The academic dress protocol table below provides a detailed overview, including images, of the appropriate attire for each group.





RESPONSIBILITY

All UGHE community members attending a UGHE graduation ceremony or formal event must comply with the above dress codes. It is the responsibility of all wearers of regalia to return them to UGHE after the event.

UGHE’s Office of the Registrar communicates graduation regalia rules to faculty, students, staff and special guests and provides them with the correct regalia before a graduation or formal event requiring regalia. The Office of the Registrar will work with the Deputy-Vice Chancellor of Academics and Research to determine which type of regalia faculty members should wear, based on the highest degree they hold.

The UGHE Office of the Registrar will establish a stock of regalia such that they can be repeatedly used for events and maintain a database of regalia to determine when new stock should be purchased. The Office of the Registrar is responsible for working with the UGHE Procurement system to purchase new regalia.

REVISION/REPLACING

This policy shall be subject to review in **five** years (26/02/2029).

EFFECTIVE DATE OF THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE POLICY
